Easy Don'ts

For Teen Workers - Clean-up Safety -

Do:

- Know work emergency procedures for electrical emergencies.
 - ✓ Use ground fault circuit (GFCIs) receptacles.
 - Remove plugs from receptacles by pulling on the plug, not the cord.
 - ✓ Wipe up spills immediately.
 - ✓ Wear appropriate waterproof non-slip footwear.
 - ✓ Be aware of hot equipment and steam.

Don't:



- Use faulty equipment or damaged receptacles or connectors.
- Plug in electrical equipment with wet hands or while touching a wet or damp surface.
- Put your fingers on the prongs while you are inserting it into an outlet.
- Pull on cords to unplug them.
- Overfill carts or containers.
